





IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Dear Orchard Ranch residents,

As we begin to grow larger, we are adding a new feature at the entrance shack. We now have an in house telephone. The number is 928-583-4504. This is to be used to notify the on duty Courtesy Patrol person that you have notified the Police, Fire Department, ambulance etc, that they are enroute to the Park, and the address that they are responding to.

Courtesy Patrol people will be on duty on Sunday from 10:00 am to midnight, Monday from midnight to 5:00:00 am, then 3:00pm to midnight. Tuesday from 3:00pm to 1:00a. Wednesday will be from 3:00pm to 1:00 am. Thursday 3:00 pm to 5:00 am. Friday will be 3:00 pm to 5:00 am, Saturday will be 10:00 am til 5:00am Sunday. The phone WILL NOT BE ACTIVE any hours other than those listed above.

This phone is to be only used to report suspicious persons, vehicles, or circumstances that need to be reported to patrol persons. It is not to be used to contact the patrol person just to talk.

If it is an EMERGENCY, always call 911 first. Your help in the use of this new tool will be immeasurable.






