<u>Credit Card Payments</u>: Call Main Office (928) 772-8266 for balance due each month. Make sure Office has your email address to get email receipts once your payment is posted.

<u>Payments made by Check</u>: Mail or put checks in Drop Box in Guard Shack. Call Main Office 928-772-8266 between 8AM-3:30PM to obtain your amount due for payments.

**PARK CLOSURES**: The Main Office is still in lockdown and the Roundhouse, Library, Fitness Center, Swimming Pool and gatherings at Pavilion are closed until further notice.
